Leaver/Dropout Recovery: Leaver/dropout recovery continues this week. We continue to look for our students who have not yet enrolled.

Pre Registration— we have completed pre registration for 9th and 10th graders, except for students who were absent. We will be calling those students to complete their pre registration.

I, NG, Blanks—a reminder that students should not have incompletes on their report cards for the semester. If a student does not make up the incomplete for any six weeks, please record the grade he/she has earned on your grade correction sheets. A student who has an incomplete in any six weeks cannot have a semester average. Also, only students who were not enrolled long enough to receive a grade should have an NG. Please do not use NG for students who were enrolled but did no work.

TSI— students who do not meet the college readiness standard with their ACT or SAT scores need to pass the TSI in order to enroll in college level courses at Texas colleges and universities. Students will have an opportunity to TSI test on campus next semester on January 16th and 25th. Registration information is available in the counseling office and on the Counseling Department webpage. Cost of all three exams is only \$16

Junior Conferences—Junior conferences will begin January 16 and run through February 14. Counselors will provide their SLC with a schedule. FAS advocates are welcome to attend the conference.

STC Registration— students in dual enrollment speech will participate in STC online registration with STC on 1/9 and 1/10.
